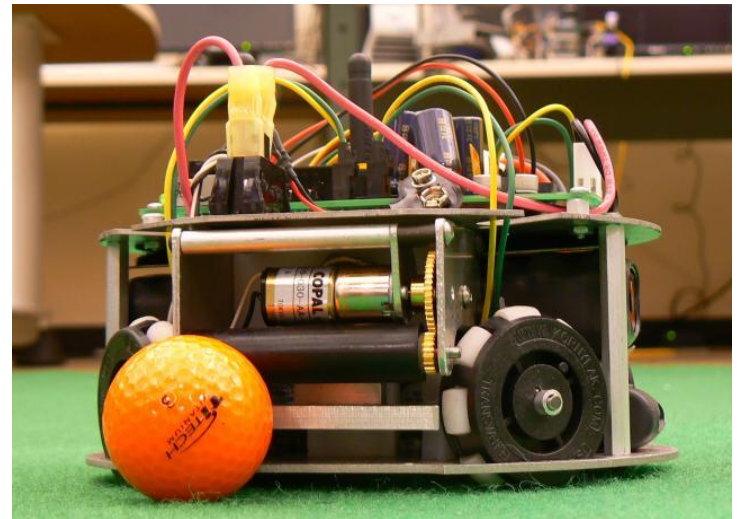

IGVC



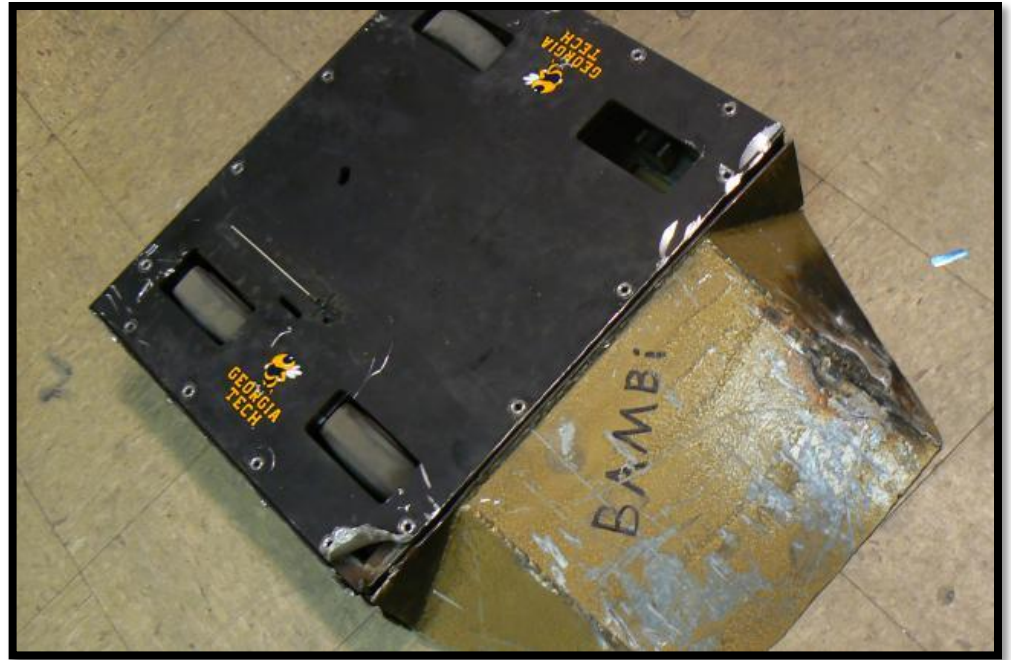
- Fully autonomous

- Engages in combat

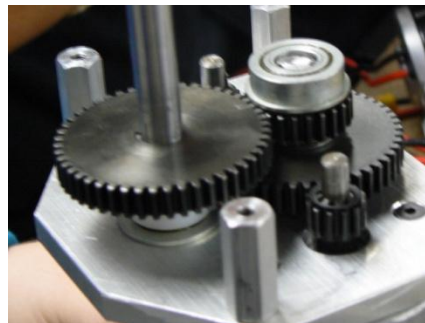

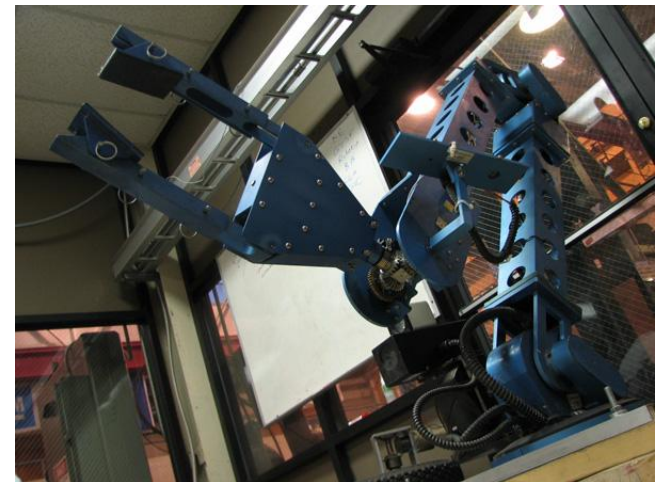
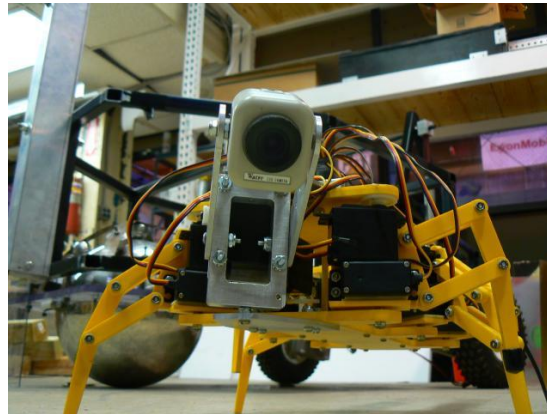
TE Sessions

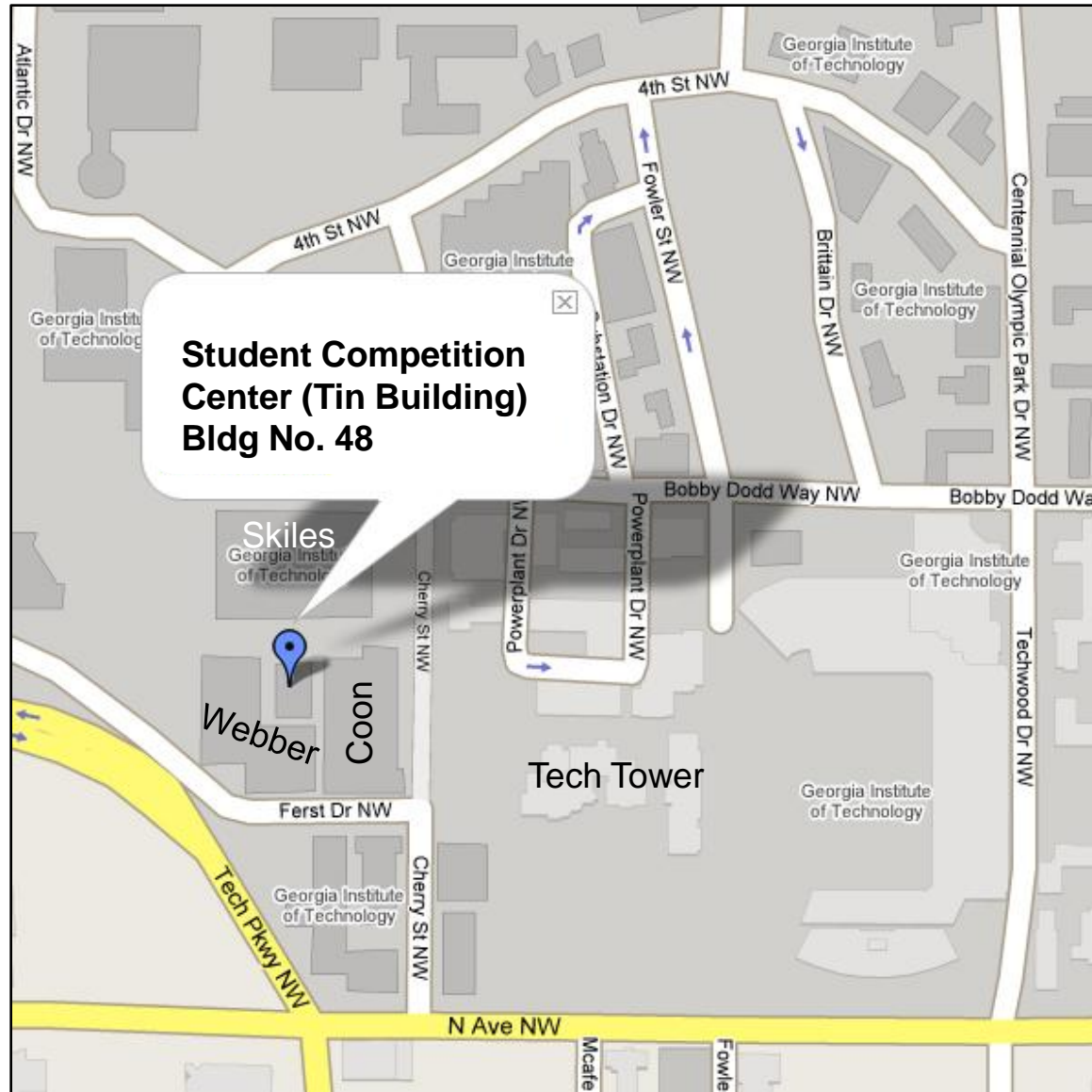
Membership Requirements
