Get the GT RoboJackets' JumpStart!

The RoboJackets' goal is to create strong FIRST teams in Georgia by giving them a solid start from which they can build successful, sustainable programs. The RoboJackets' JumpStart program aims to accomplish this by providing a technical background, financial support, and engineering advisement for a limited number of FIRST Robotics Competition teams.

Technical instruction and training will be carried out in the form of Technology Enrichment workshops, in which students are taught relevant technical skills through hands-on robotics related projects. Financial support will be garnered through donations of local and larger companies and distributed as grants of \$1,500 for robot construction from the RoboJackets to participating teams. Also, additional engineering support and advisement will be provided throughout the FIRST competition season in the form of brainstorming sessions, advisement sessions, and limited machining assistance.

In order to ensure the quality of each team's experience, all participating teams must agree to fulfill requirements such as the following:

- Participation in the FIRST Robotics Competition for 2008
- •Attendance of a complete Technology Enrichment program (Basic or Advanced)
- •Attendance of local the FIRST Kickoff and Brainstorming Session(s)
- •Participation in weekly design and build meetings during the FIRST build season

The requirements will be enumerated in more detail in an acceptance document upon a team's selection for the program.
